## Summer Hikes 2018

Saturday, June 9  
9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.  
**Seabird Walk**

Join biologist Shannon Brinkman on a walk to expand your knowledge of seabirds that make the California Coastal National Monument their home. The hike will end with a visit to the historic and still operational Trinidad Lighthouse. Meet at the Trinidad Head trail.

Saturday, June 16  
8 a.m. to 10 a.m.  
**Low Tide at Luffenholtz Beach**

Enjoy an early morning low tide walk at Luffenholtz Beach with geologist and naturalist, Danny O'Shea. Learn more about the geology of the area and the intertidal life that make their home on the rocks. Meet at Luffenholtz beach parking lot.

Sunday, July 1  
10 a.m. to 12 p.m.  
**Introduction to Lichens**

Do you like lichens? Learn more about this fascinating life form that puts fungi, a photosynthetic partner and a yeast together in a symbiotic relationship inspiring wonder in those who take the time to take a closer look. Meet at the Trinidad State Beach entrance parking lot off Stagecoach Road.

**Old Home Beach Low Tide Walk**

Hike the Parker Creek Trail to Old Home Beach where Allie Lindgren, lineal descendant from the Tsurai Village, will share her perspective on the importance of the area to native people. Meet at the Trinidad Coastal Land Trust office.\*

8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.  
**Easy Intertidal Exploration**

Explore the low tide at the Trinidad Pier during this slow-paced, easy access walk. The beach at Trinidad Pier is relatively easy to explore and we will have a beach wheel chair available for those who need it. An intertidal expert will be on-hand to help identify sea life. Meet at the Trinidad Pier. This hike is co-sponsored by the Trinidad Coastal Land Trust and the Friends of the Dunes.

Sunday, August 26  
9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.  
**Trinidad Head Plant Walk**

Discover the lush plant life of Trinidad Head during this plant walk focused on learning more about our green neighbors. The hike will include basic identification and some stories about medicinal and edible uses. Meet at the Trinidad Head trail.
