2019 stewardship trail work days

Land stewardship work and trail improvements are a focus for our Land Trust to help protect and conserve Trinidad's scenic coast and beautiful beaches. We host volunteer work day events about monthly. Stay tuned for more details. These are advertised on our TCLT Facebook page, website calendar and local media. Thanks to our committed volunteers from Humboldt State University's Natural Resources Club, SlackLiners Club, Rock Climbing Club, and Arcata High's Surfriders Club.

First Saturdays of month, 9:30am-12pm (unless otherwise noted)

- **February 9:** TCLT teams up with California State Parks to help remove invasive plants like ivy and broom, which are taking over sensitive habitats on our scenic bluffs and forests.
- **March 2:** Baker Beach and Sotsin Point trail improvements and ivy removal. We are slowly but surely helping this coastal forest headland ecosystem by removing invasive plant species that limit this unique habitat.
- **April 6:** Martin Creek Trail improvements and ivy removal. This conservation easement trail over private property is rugged and sensitive. Sturdy shoes required. Call for details and directions.
- **May 4:** Meet at Houda Point for our annual spring beach trail repair day: help us restabilize the shoreline trail steps, where the trail meets the beach, after huge winter waves have undermined the cable steps. We restabilize the steps with rocks and logs. At both Houda Point and Baker Beach.
- **June 1:** Meet at Houda Point to finish trail improvements (trail steps, brush clearing) at Houda Point, Luffenholtz Beach. More details will be posted.

June 9-15 - TCLT Trails Week: American Hiking Society volunteers join the trail crew w/ new TCLT volunteers and some veterans to replace trail steps at Luffenholtz Beach and Tepona Point. Last summer we spent the week working on the three Houda Point trails. Wow those trails look good! Thanks to our volunteer coordinators John Calkins, Don Allan, Charles Netzow and Steen and Tami Trump.

2019 Pacout GreenTeam Scenic Drive pick-ups: Third Saturday of month 9-10am, every other month. Meet at upper parking area near Luffenholtz Beach. We break up into small groups and patrol Scenic Drive for garbage. Pac out provides all materials; disposal and we raffle off gift certificates after the group photo.
