### **Introduction to Exploring Intertidal Habitats**

Enjoy an easy access exploration of the intertidal habitats around Trinidad Head. Meet in the parking area near the north base of Trinidad Head. Plus optional lighthouse tour.

### **Baker Beach Bioblitz**

Trinidad Coastal Land Trust, Friends of the Dunes and the Marine Protected Area Collaborative team up to participate in a BioBlitz of the California coast. ### **Pilot Point Tour**
